**WINTER JUDGED SHOW WILL BE  
THEME - PLUS MINIATURES**

The theme will be "**Winter Holiday Show**". It will be judged in categories as usual. You may enter any subject you want, but we will give a prize for best of theme. Miniatures will be an extra category. You may enter two pieces plus one miniature. **Important:** Miniature must not be any larger than 108 square inches. Example: 108" equals 9x12 being the **Outside of Frame**. Therefore the artwork will be smaller depending on the frame width. If your width times the length of outside of frame is 108" or less, that qualifies.

**IMPORTANT TO READ FOR GALLERY SITTERS**

We have put an info sheet under the desk glass explaining each sale and what to do.

1. Please write all information: Buyer name, address, phone, and e-mail.
2. Artist's name and name & number of artwork - plus your name as seller.
3. Please train new members thoroughly.
4. \*Suggest leaving key in lock-box after opening the gate & change the combination. It has been lost many times on the desk etc. Very inconvenient.
5. Please do not put notes under glass or tape on top.
6. Please make sure the big table is straightened up and looks nice. The City sometimes has small meetings there and leave things out of place.
7. Please do not change or write on art cards. If we make a mistake we will fix it.
8. Please fill out show registrations carefully!
9. Keep the beautiful artwork coming in, we are getting lots of compliments.

## **OCTOBER DEMONSTRATOR**

**ROGER FOLK**  
Sunday, October 14,  
3pm, Ole Hanson Rm

Recognition and growing demand for his drawings and paintings led Roger Folk to abandon a successful commercial career as marketing art director of Disneyland and devote full time to Fine Art. Today he is an accomplished watercolorist whose mastery in portraying a wide variety of subjects with authority and sensitivity has earned him the respect of art critics and collectors throughout the United States and the world.

Folk, who is best known for his coastscapes, paintings of shorebirds and children on the beach, makes Yosemite National Park his studio. Since 1982 Roger has been an annual guest instructor and seminar leader and in 1986 he was invited to be the first participant in their artist-in-residence



program. Roger was juried in as a signature member of the National Watercolor Society in 1978. He has served eight years on the Board of Directors.

Roger Folk exhibits in various judged and invitational shows annually, including the Laguna Beach Festival of Arts. Two times he has been a juror for the latter, as well as many other respected shows.

Roger's demonstration will be devoted to organizing your painting using preliminary studies, strong composition, and techniques for adding life to your art.
