CALIFORNIA ART FAIR

The California State Fair is pleased to announce a different kind of paint-out. We're calling it **Plein Air at the Fair**.

If you aren't familiar with **California Fine Art**, the annual juried fine art show of the California State Fair, let me start by explaining that a long-standing tradition of the show has been to invite artists to demonstrate during the Fair. Currently, each of these artists set up temporary studios for 3 to 6 days in our exhibit hall (Building 7 of Expo Center) and make art. Because many of the over 100,000 Fair Visitors who come through California Fine Art are not frequenters of museums and/or galleries, often our exhibit is their first encounter with fine art. The live demonstrations enable visitors to see how various artforms are created and the interaction between artists and visitors is often very rewarding as well as educational.

This year, in honor of the Fair's theme, *"Beach Party,"* we added a New Division to the competition, Division 450, *"At the Water's Edge - Plein Air."* Your entries are welcome!

In addition to adding this feature to the show, we are also instituting a new concept in art demonstrations. This is where the paint-out part comes in.

Our concept is to invite plein air painters to set up their easels at various venues around the fairgrounds, taking the art demonstrations to the Fair, so to speak. Currently we are considering venues, and working out the logistics. And, we're inviting individual artists and Plein Air Societies to participate.

Like our indoor demonstrators, Plein Air painters will be provided with credential Fair entry credential parking for the day(s) they are participating. The plein air painters will also be able to offer or distribute promotional material to Fair Visitors who are interested in purchasing from the artists. We also hope to reserve a small area of the exhibit hall for a special "rotating" exhibit of the paintings that are

being created at the Fair by the plein air painters.

This year's State Fair Dates are: Friday, August 12th through Monday September 5th (Labor Day). The Fair will be closed on Mondays except Labor Day. We hope to have one to three plein air painters at three to four of the venues each day the Fair is open.
