## **IMPOR TANT GALLER Y SIZE AND PRICE CHANGES**

1. Maximum horizontal width (Including Frame) = **48"**
2. If picture exceeds **36"** in width (including frame) it will be counted as **2 entries** .
3. Only **2 entries** per artist each show (Public Choice and Judged).
4. \$10 per entry. (Picture over 36" would be \$20.00)
5. Gallery sitting: sign up one time for each entry.
6. No prints allowed! (Accept shrink wrap in the bins, 5 per show at \$1.00 ea.).
7. If canvas is not framed, must be stretched and tacked to the back and continue the painting on all sides.
8. Wired to hang.
9. Started and completed within the last 5 years.
10. Clean and fresh frames and matting etc.
